To submit a compliment:

1. Fill out a compliment card and leave it with any employee. They will pass the card along to a supervisor.
2. Call us at (757)385-1971 and explain why you are calling.
3. Email your compliment to ps0@vbso.net. Ensure the word "Compliment" appears in the subject line of the email.

It would be helpful if the name of the deputy or employee involved is known, but if the name is unknown, just tell us about the incident and we will attempt to find out who was involved. It would also be helpful to know where and when the incident took place.
